Choose an activity to complete each day:

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| <p><u>CVC words:</u> Use your 15 sound cards/bottle tops to create CVC words (consonant, vowel, consonant e.g. cat, dog, pin, sun)</p> | <p><u>Word Box Words:</u> Practise sounding out and blending your word box words.</p> | <p><u>Rainbow Word Box Words:</u> Trace each letter with every colour in the rainbow.</p> |
| <p><u>Shaving cream fun:</u> In a tub or on a tray, write your sounds or word box words in shaving cream.</p> | <p><u>Magazine collage:</u> Cut out letters from newspapers or magazines. Match the letters or build a word.</p> | <p><u>List fun:</u> Write a list. Some ideas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A list of everyone in your family;• A shopping list;• A food menu• A list of your favourite things |
| <p><u>Bookmaking:</u> Staple pieces of paper together to make a book. Then draw pictures and ask an adult to help write your story (or have a go yourself!)</p> | <p><u>Play dough:</u> Make lowercase and uppercase letters with playdough. (You can find a recipe for playdough on the internet 😊)</p> | <p><u>Digraph Practise:</u> Practise sounding out your digraphs – Remember digraphs are two letters that come together to make 1 sound. Make a list of words that have these digraphs: ai, oa, ie, ee, or, ng, oo.</p> |
| <p><u>Nature Play:</u> Go outside and find leaves or sticks. See if you can create letters or words.</p> | <p><u>Singing:</u> Sing the alphabet song to someone else and teach them a nursery rhyme.</p> | <p><u>Rhyme Time:</u> Create a list of words that rhyme or make a rhyming book. Some words you could use: dog, log... wig, pig.... sun, fun...</p> |
