Create a piece of artwork inspired by the artist.</p>	<p>Research a famous Aboriginal person e.g. singer, inventor, sportsperson etc. Make a PowerPoint or a poster presentation about them.</p>	<p>Research Aboriginal symbols used in artwork. Think of an original story and tell it by drawing it with the symbols.</p>
<p>Explain how Aboriginal names were used to describe different areas in Australia. Write down examples.</p>	<p>Research the symbolic meaning of the colours of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander flags.</p>	<p>Research a place in Australia that interests you. Write down information about this place into your own words. Include pictures of this place if possible.</p>	<p>List and illustrate natural and man-made places around Australia. You may need to use books and the internet to find these places.</p>
<p>Propose new words to the National Anthem – using same tune.</p>	<p>Devise an AUSTRALIA ‘Trivia’ type game.</p>	<p>List 10 new uses for gum leaves. You might like to create some of your ideas. E.g. necklace, bookmarks etc.....</p>	<p>Make a collage of Multicultural Australia.</p>
<p>Create an A-Z list of Australian animals. Then combine two of the animals to make a new species. Write its new name and draw a labelled diagram describing its features. e.g kangaroo + platypus = kangapus</p>	<p>Illustrate and display a variety of typical and unique Aussie road signs</p>	<p>Create a model of Australia or something that you think represents Australia. Label the model.</p>	<p>Make a jigsaw puzzle from a map of Australia to indicate the state/territory divisions. Make sure the states/territories are labelled. Ask someone to put it together.</p>
