Draw a person animal alien. Label the body parts that you know. (occhi, naso, bocca)	Make a book. Use colour or number words.	Teach someone how to count in Italian.	Introduce all your teddies to someone. Come ti chiami? Mi chiamo.....
Record yourself singing one of our Italian songs. (with a brother or sister, if you can)	Make a card game using Italian words. e.g. concentration	Write Italian number words on cards. Shuffle put in order.	Write the days of the week. Shuffle put in order.
Ask someone to guess the day of the week you are saying in Italian.	Start an Italian word list. You can add to this each day. See how many Italian words you know without help.	Take a walk around your house. Point to all the yellow things. Say 'giallo' to each one. Do the same with 'rosso' red and 'verde' green.	Play 'avanti' (go) 'fermati' (stop) with someone.
Make a parrot puppet out of an old toilet roll. Do a little play saying the Pappagallo rhyme.	Make a paper chain. Use colour to make a pattern. (Bianco, rosso, verde)	Write the words 'su' (up) 'giu' (down) lots of times on bits of paper. Stick them around the house on high things(su) and low things(giu)	Make an Italian flag and an Australian flag.

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
