

Dear Parents,

This is a letter outlining home learning expectations.

I have created a project on Radio Plays that has been differentiated for different year levels. This would include creating the Foley sounds and creating different voices for the characters for the play I have provided, ***The Three Little Pigs***.

The reason I have done this is to encourage siblings in the same house hold to work on similar aspects of the project together, even if their sibling is learning music this term, as the music students can create Foley sounds for their soundscapes alongside drama students creating Foley sounds for their Radio Plays.

You can find the project, in detail, on SeeSaw in your child's class. This will include a file explaining the project, and video links that explain and give examples of the different aspects of the project (Voice acting, Radio Plays, Foley Sounds), and a PDF document of the script for The Three Little Pigs.

I have also included a choice board which includes parts of the project, acting exercises and movement breaks. The parts that include the project are highlighted and at least two of these must be done within your child's allocated Arts bracket in their class timetable.

All communications are to take place through your child's SeeSaw, which I'll have access to.

I hope that this project provides an engaging way to access the Drama curriculum during this time at home.
