We would like to thank everyone for your continual support and understanding in these difficult times. The Year 7 team have created a learning plan for those families who have opted to keep their children home. The work that students are doing at home is a continuation of what has already begun at school. Those students who are at school will be doing the same tasks and completing assignments.

We try to social distance as best we can at school but as you can imagine, keeping a 1.5m distance at all times with students is not always possible. We do continually ask students to wash their hands regularly throughout the day. If anyone has any handwashing pump soap they can spare or tissues, that would be great.

If you do decide to keep your child at home, to enable us to keep attendance records accurate, please let their teacher or the office know and for how long. For example 'we are keeping [students name] at home until the end of term 1 because of Covid-19.'
